- 1. Attendees Mike Phillips, Jack Heidenreich, Kyle Boczkowski, Fred Robinson, Jim Petros, Dave Silveri, Stan Petrohovich, Rich Bull, David George
- 2. Approval of April 2023 meeting minutes minutes were approved as issued.
- Tournament Director report In Willie's absence, the group discussed the issue of slow play (again....). Jack said he will be riding around the match at Dunes West so will ask groups who fall behind to pick up their pace. We'll see what impact that has on speed of play. No other tournament issues were identified.
- Handicap Director report the group again acknowledged the excellent work Mike does in managing the website and in updating the dashboard after each match. No other concerns were identified. Mike has updated the documents on the website with all of the comments (1) received pursuant to his request.
- 5. Treasurer's report we currently have \$5,120 in our account. With 2 matches remaining, David estimates we will have ~\$5,600 at the end of the year. We would have enough for 2 charities to receive \$2,500 each (see charity selection discussion below). We are averaging about \$175 over the past 6 months from the 50/50 raffles. See attached notes from Treasurer.
- 6. Charity selections for 2023 we discussed a number of options for charities after reviewing the history of our donations since 2010 (slide attached). The Board agreed unanimously to donate to 2 charities Neighbors Together (formerly Tricounty Family ministries) and The ARC of the Lowcountry. Stan will contact Neighbors, and Kyle will contact The ARC. We hope to have both send representatives to the January match at Charleston National. For the check presentation.
- 7. Election of Officers Willie agreed to step down and Kyle volunteered to replace him as the Tournament Chairman for 2024. The remaining officers Jim Petros, Mike Phillips and David George all agreed to serve another year. The full slate was approved. But we should be looking for additional volunteers to step up in coming years. Willie had previously volunteered to help manage a skins game if we go forward with that (see item below).

#### 8. Old Business/Action items

 Rivertowne team - We agreed that only Berkeley players who have played YTD thru October 2023 are eligible to play for Rivertowne. Mike P stated that we have 12 Berkeley who have played for Rivertowne thus far this year. - Skins Game Preparation - The group of Kyle, Willie and Mike developed some ideas on different formats to "liven up" our Interclub schedule. The group agreed some type of a skins game may be the best option; it would be voluntary, but lots of the details need to be fleshed out – cost, recordkeeping, sign-up process, etc. **ACTION:** Rich and Kyle agreed to work out the process details of the skins game and send around to the Board for further review and input. Target should be to start up Skins Game in January.
