Minutes from Interclub Spring Board Meeting of April 18, 2018 Coosaw Creek

1. Minutes from Fall 2017 meeting, read and approve.

2. Tournament Director Report

- A. We need to speed up the process for getting the cards in for shingling. The directors should do them as they come in and put them in the posting bin. If you also use the cards for personal team statistics, you should also log that data in before putting them in the posting bin, but do it as you get the cards in.
- B. It would be best to have at least one person, director or player, remain to the end to pick up the certificates for their team optimum would be the player stayed and got his own certificate.

3. Handicap Director Report

- A. Pulled points and certificate distribution continue to be evenly placed between the different levels of players.
- B. Directors: For importing Roster information directly into host club Pro Shop tournament software, find out if your club would like a data file containing roster information such as last name, first name, club, and points for each event? Regardless, Mike wants to provide for each event, via email, this data file AND a PDF file that can be printed which shows the same information. Email David George with your results.

4. Treasurer's Report

We have far collected an average of \$200 at each of the four tournaments so far this year. Expenses from that total were \$34.

5. Open Agenda Items

- A. Some Pro Shops may be unable to generate final score sheets for posting on scoreboards because of a new tournament software program (program name unknown) that does not have that capability. Gene Weir created a spreadsheet, which Mike posted as a spreadsheet (MS Excel) AND a universally usable PDF (Acrobat Reader) file on the Interclub website, for clubs to use if they don't have the right software to create the score sheets. (Gene)
- B. Gene Weir suggested the 'Fisher House' for a charity this year. They support veterans' families who are Patients in the VA Hospital. (Gene) It is now open

- and the Directors voted to add Fisher House to our list of possible charities for the fall meeting.
- C. It is not permissible for the player to keep their own score card. Carts trade cards to each other before the beginning of the round. Failure to do so is disqualification of the player. (Dave G)
- D. Club Director will do the 50/50 when they are hosting the match. (Rich)
 - 1. The goal is a total of \$400 per tournament with \$200 going to our account
 - 2. Once finished with the 50/50, the director will give the supplies and tickets to the director of the next match
- E. Website form for team rosters. Mike created a new website form for putting together event rosters that can be found on our website in the Director's Only section for the Forms and Document area. Mike will provide instructions to directors as to how to use the form and will work with Al for the next couple of months as we "trial" this new method for putting together event teams and providing this information to the clubs in an importable data file as well as a file for printing rosters. This should be a better process for Interclub Directors as well as saving time for most clubs by providing a data file for easy import into their tournament software programs. (Mike)
 - 1. It was decided that Wednesday night before the tournament Monday is the deadline to have your team roster listing in the website roster.
 - 2. You can put the points for your players in the Points column in the form, Al will correct them before the information is sent to the host/event clubs.
- F. Any other new or old business items?
 - 1. Agreed to start the directors on holes 1, 2 and 10 to get hopefully get them in faster to be read to get the cards started for posting.
 - 2. Have all players bring their cards to the scoring area and put them in the team bins BEFORE going to the parking lot to unload.
 - 3. If possible, have your players keep a separate card for you to do and keep any team records keeping that you do rather than hold all your cards for one single posting when you are done with them.
