

# Charleston Area Men's Interclub Golf Association

Fall 2024 Meeting Minutes  
October 23, 2024 – 10am at Coosaw Creek Country Club

## 1. Attendees:

Present: Mike Phillips, Fred Robinson, Jim Petros, Stan Petrohovich, David George, Bernie Rotundo (Chas Muni), and Ed New (Shadowmoss rep).

Absent: Jack Heidenreich, Kyle Boczkowski, Dave Silveri (sent Rep), Jim Delaney, and Willie Charles

We welcomed Bernie Rotundo as the new Interclub Director from Charleston Muni.

## 2. Old Business:

a) **Spring Meeting Minutes Approval:** May 2024 Fall BoD meeting minutes were approved without changes.

b) **Tournament Director report:** In Kyle's absence, we discussed how to improve the timing for issuing results after each match. We will reinforce the roles for the Directors in helping get results finalized and posted, as discussed at the May BOD meeting.

- 1) **Fred and Jack** will handle getting the team scores posted on the "big board", with or without the host pro's assistance.
- 2) **Jim P and Stan** will manage the scorecard shingling.
- 3) **Kyle and Willie** will manage the skins scorecards processing and final payouts;
- 4) **Bernie and Jim D** will assist where needed.
- 5) **David and Dave** will handle the "All Scorecards" basket - IN Skins cards to Skin Processing and Not in Skins cards to the team baskets – additionally they will move the processed Skins cards to the Team Baskets.
- 6) **Jim P** will print out sheets to remind players to pick up the CTP markers after they complete their round.
- 7) **Directors** are responsible for taking their scorecards and filling out their Team Results Sheets, then distributing the scorecards (without waiting on all scorecards) to the Shingling Area (basket), and their Team Results Sheets when completely filled out to the Scoreboard Area (basket). Reminder: Directors need to ensure the +/- score is written and circled at top right corner of scorecard to indicate their review/accuracy check and for help the speed and accuracy of Shingling process.

### c) **Handicap Director Report:**

- 1) Mike reviewed the process we currently use to manage the scorecards and ensure skins info is compiled correctly. The work process is attached to these notes. Each Director should be sure they know the process and reinforce it with their teams.

- 2) Mike reviewed the website where each Director can review their players points and targets over time. You can also calculate the target for a new player on the website. Each **Director** should review their roster and remove any players who no longer play in the Interclub.

d) **Treasurer's Report:** As of the meeting date, we had \$3,843 in our account. We have seen a drop in 50/50 income, possibly due to money going to the skins competition. Based on planned expenditures for the lunch at the meeting, and the trophy cost, we should still have sufficient funds to award \$4,400 in donations. Our website cost will be due in December, 2025; in 2022 the cost was \$311 for 3 years.

e) **Skins competition:** Mike reviewed the data details on the skins competitions for the year. All of the data by match and winning skins is available on the website. **Directors** are requested to collect the skins money from their players in advance and make one payment the morning of the match to simplify the skins registration/check-in process. We will still allow players to sign up for skins the morning of the match.

### 3. New Business

a) **2025 Contracts:** From the meeting, we collected copy contracts for Crowfield, Legend Oaks, Wescott and Pine Forest; I added Coosaw Creek after the meeting. **Kyle** needs to tell us if there are any outstanding contracts; we want to finalize and publish the Interclub schedule for 2025. We agreed to keep the 2025 fee at \$45 per golfer.

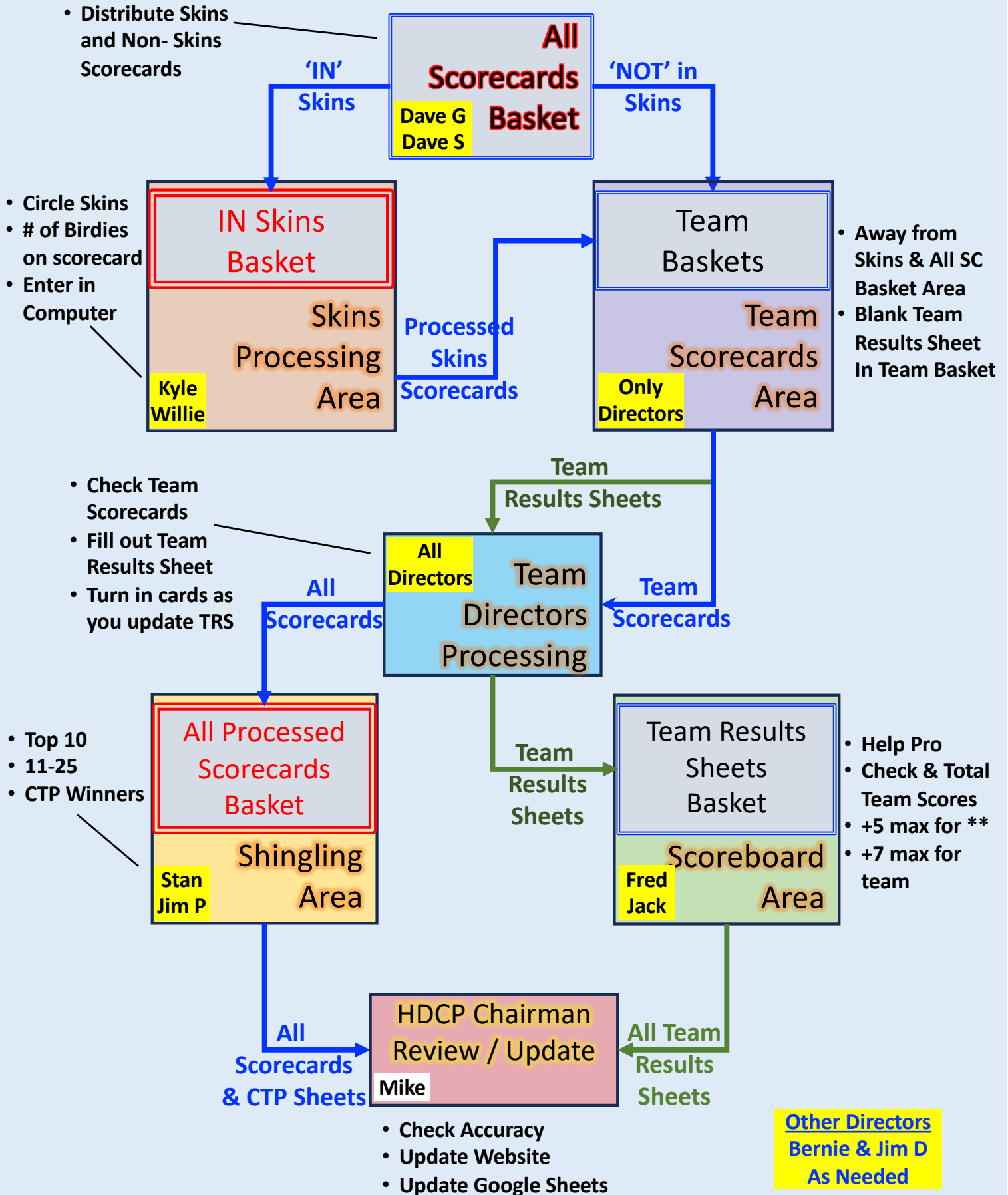
b) **2025 Charity Selection:** we reviewed the list of charities we have donated to since 2010. Based on the estimated amount of funds available at the end of the year, we agreed to donate \$2,200 to 2 charities. After discussion we agreed to donate to First Tee and Holy City Missions. **Stan** will contact HC Missions; **David** will contact First Tee. We will plan to present their checks to them at the January match at Charleston National. The updated list of our charities is attached.

c) **Election of Officers:** It was agreed that Jim, David G and Mike will retain their roles as President, Treasurer and Handicap Director. Kyle has asked to relinquish the Tournament Director role. After some lengthy discussion about whether to replace the role in kind, it was agreed that **Jim** would re-draft the Tournament Director responsibilities, and the **full BOD** would review and comment. We will assess whether some of the roles can be incorporated into other roles.

d) **Cash Prizes vice Gift Certificates:** Mike discussed this with some numbers as a future idea. The group felt we had long way to go before we could broach this to members and clubs.
